5. Nodal Officer dealing with Scholarships for students from the Minority community

- Collecting data about students who have received scholarships
- Collection of reports and information of Govt. of MP, Govt. of India and AICTE's orders on various aspects of education and employment of these categories of students.
- Carrying out capacity-building programmes for these students, as per the need.
- Providing a mechanism to redress the grievance of students from these communities
- Sending reports to the respective Govt. Departments/Commissions about the number of students enrolled.
